Professor Maria Teresa Costa Campi has a Degree in Economic Sciences and a PhD (Cum Laude) in Economics from the University of Barcelona. She is Professor of Economics (Spanish Economy) in the Faculty of Economics and Business at the University of Barcelona, since 1987. Apart from the academia she has served as President of the Association of Latin American Energy Regulators (ARIAE), and President of the Spanish National Energy Commission (CNE).

In research related activities, she has been Guest-editor of three Special Issues in Energy Policy, and Scientific director of International Academic Symposium organized annually by the Chair of Energy Sustainability and the Medreg Forum. She is member of the editorial board of the Journal of Applied Economics. Maria Teresa is also member of the Steering Committee in Barcelona Institute of Economics (IEB). Currently, she is the Director of the Chair of Energy Sustainability at IEB-University of Barcelona.

Her research interest is on energy economics focussing in specific branches like drivers and determinants of energy R&D, energy efficiency, environmental innovation, regulation and policy analysis. She has published more than 75 articles in academic journals and has also written more than 90 book chapters.
